

**Be Bold, Be Here!**  
Attendance Matters

According to the Conroe ISD Attendance policy, a child “must attend at least 90% of the days the class is offered” to receive credit in a class or be promoted to the next grade level. Our goal at Broadway is that 97% of students be present each day.

**Be Bold, Be Here!** is our attendance program this year and here is how it will work:

1. Each teacher will be given a **Be Bold, Be Here!** sign to place in their classroom. Each day that the class has 100% in attendance (ie, no tardies and no early pull outs) the teacher will place a sticker on the sign. When a class earns 10 stickers, they will earn a prize of their choice from a list of prizes. When they earn 10 more stickers, they will earn a prize of their choice from the list and so on and so on throughout the year.
2. Our policy has changed since previous years. Perfect Attendance, per Broadway’s attendance incentive, is defined as a child being here at school every day, being on time and staying the entire day. If a child is tardy or is pulled out early, they will not be considered for a perfect attendance award. However; the district’s policy of attendance has not changed; if your child is here before 9:05 a.m., they will be counted present (per the district) on their report card. **Be Bold, Be Here!** is a Broadway attendance initiative.
3. The only exceptions to this are on the days when there are school celebrations, Walk of Fame days, Party days, promotion days, etc.
4. Perfect Attendance awards: The Perfect Attendance awards will go to those children who have been present every day, have been on-time (i.e., no tardies) and have stayed the entire day (i.e., no early pull-outs).
