## What is the Hall of Fame?

Our 1st nine weeks Hall of Fame will be held on Friday, October 13th @ 2:00 p.m. Students will be making a loop in the front parking lot and parents of students in the Hall of Fame are welcome to come watch outside.
We celebrate good character traits by giving students Star Coupons which are given out when a student is caught demonstrating a good character trait.
When a student earns 10 Star Coupons (except for the first nine weeks, they only must earn 5) they make it into the Broadway Hall of Fame. Students will receive a Hall of Fame certificate that states the date and time of the Hall of Fame, and their student will be given a T-shirt to take home and wear on the day of the Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame will start inside the building, for students, and then a loop around the front parking lot will be made for parents. A student can be in the Hall of Fame more than once, but they will only receive one $t$-shirt.
