Thank you for your support in the recent election! Conroe ISD voters turned out to pass three of the four propositions in Bond 2023. The three propositions total \$1.973 billion, 98.8% of the funds in Bond 2023, and will have a two-cent impact on the tax rate. Board Policy: PK-6 Cell Phone and Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly **before** school and **after** school.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should not be used to capture video, audio, or images at school or on the bus.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should be set on silent mode and kept in backpacks, lockers, or other designated storage areas and should not be visible during school hours including instructional time, reward time, free time, lunch, and in the hallways.
- Use of cell phones and smartwatches may be permitted in extenuating circumstances with permission from a staff member. *(ex. to notify parent/ guardian of a late bus)*

Library News

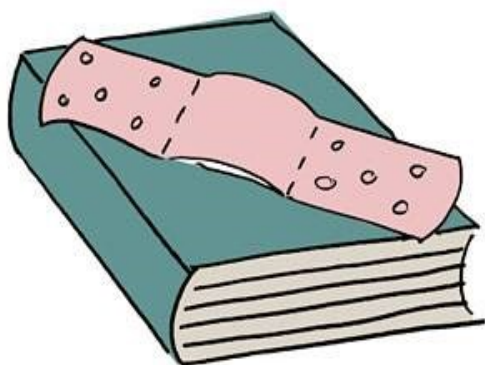
Our Broadway library has open check out every morning from 7:35 – 8:15. If your child is absent, forgot their book on their library day, or ready to get some new books they can come to the library any morning before school until 8:15.

Recently, we have had water damaged books returned almost daily. Water bottles travel with our students daily and accidents are happening quite frequently. I provide zip lock bags in the library at all times. I also check with students to make sure they have one in their backpack at all times. If water damage occurs a letter is sent home with the amount for me to replace the damaged books. Each book is library bound therefore has to be purchased through one of our district's approved library book vendors. There are three options for a damaged or lost book to be paid for: check with D.O.B and D.L. #, EXACT cash, or School Cash Online. If you find a lost book that has been paid for before the end of the school year it can be returned and a refund will be mailed.

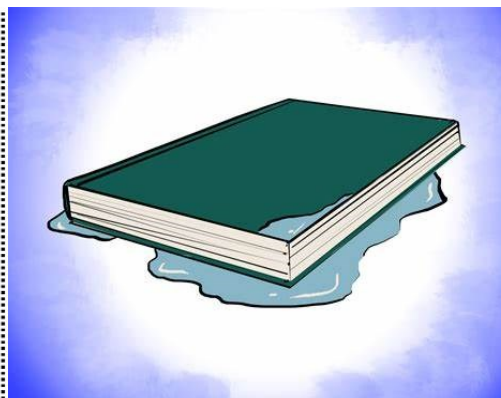

Referrals for Gifted & Talented Testing

Referral requests are now open for the CISD Gifted & Talented program. Although the testing will not take place until late January, referral requests are accepted at this time. Referral requests can be made by the parents and/or campus staff. It is recommended that parents of 2nd grade students wait until CogAT scores have arrived before nominating their child because CogAT scores are part of the GT assessment in October. If you are interested in referring your child, you may want to discuss this with your child's teacher. Referrals will be accepted October 2-December 15. The referral form is located on the next page or you may request one from the front office. You can also find the referral form and other GT information on the CISD GT homepage.

- *Visitors must return their sticker at the front desk after every visit.
- *Refrain from leaving the designated cafeteria area.
- *Speak to the receptionist for any questions.
