Board Policy:

PK-6 Cell Phone and Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly **before** school and **after** school.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should not be used to capture video, audio, or images at school or on the bus.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should be set on silent mode and kept in backpacks, lockers, or other designated storage areas and should not be visible during school hours including instructional time, reward time, free time, lunch, and in the hallways.
- Use of cell phones and smartwatches may be permitted in extenuating circumstances with permission from a staff member. (ex. to notify parent/guardian of a late bus)

Please Help prevent Wet & Damaged Library Books!


Our Broadway library has open check out every morning from 7:35-8:15. If your child is absent, forgot their book on their library day, or ready to get some new books they can come to the library any morning before school until 8:15.

Recently, we have had water damaged books returned almost daily. Water bottles travel with our students daily and accidents are happening quite frequently. I provide zip lock bags in the library at all times. I also check with students to make sure they have one in their backpack at all times. If water damage occurs a letter is sent home with the amount for me to replace the damaged books. Each book is library bound therefore has to be purchased through one of our district's approved library book vendors. There are three options for a damaged or lost book to be paid for: check with D.O.B and D.L. #, EXACT cash, or School Cash Online. If you find a lost book that has been paid for before the end of the school year it can be returned and a refund will be mailed.





Lunch Visitor expectation:

Please review our procedures and select an available slot to sign up for lunch with your student.

- *Due to our school capacity only two (2) visitors are allowed per student, small children count toward this limit.
- *You may only sign-up to eat lunch with your student, not friends of students.
- *To give everyone an opportunity, please sign-up only once (1) every three weeks.
- *All visitors MUST have a government issued ID that we can scan through our system at every visit.
- *Visitors may only bring food/treats for their student. No food or treats may be given to other siblings or students.
- *Visitors must return their sticker at the front desk after every visit.
- *Refrain from leaving the designated cafeteria area.
