## 5 P's OF COLD WEATHER PREPAREDNESS

### PROTECT PLANTS

Cover cold-sensitive plants to protect them from dangerous temperatures.

### PROTECT PETS

Bring outdoor pets inside or provide a warm shelter for them.

### PRACTICE FIRE SAFETY

Use safe heating sources indoors. Do not use fuel-burning devices such as grills; they release deadly carbon monoxide.



### PROTECT PEOPLE

Dress in warm layers and wear a hat and gloves.



### PROTECT PIPES

Cover pipes and allow outdoor faucets to slowly drip to prevent them from freezing and breaking.

## Board Policy: PK-6 Cell Phone and Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly **before** school and **after** school.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should not be used to capture video, audio, or images at school or on the bus.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should be set on silent mode and kept in backpacks, lockers, or other designated storage areas and should not be visible during school hours including instructional time, reward time, free time, lunch, and in the hallways.
- Use of cell phones and smartwatches may be permitted in extenuating circumstances with permission from a staff member. (*ex. to notify parent/ guardian of a late bus*)

## Please Help Prevent **Wet & Damaged** **Library Books!**



Our Broadway library has open check out every morning from 7:35 – 8:15. If your child is absent, forgot their book on their library day, or ready to get some new books they can come to the library any morning before school until 8:15.

Recently, we have had water damaged books returned almost daily. Water bottles travel with our students daily and accidents are happening quite frequently. I provide zip lock bags in the library at all times. I also check with students to make sure they have one in their backpack at all times. If water damage occurs a letter is sent home with the amount for me to replace the damaged books. Each book is library bound therefore has to be purchased through one of our district's approved library book vendors. There are three options for a damaged or lost book to be paid for: check with D.O.B and D.L. #, EXACT cash, or School Cash Online. 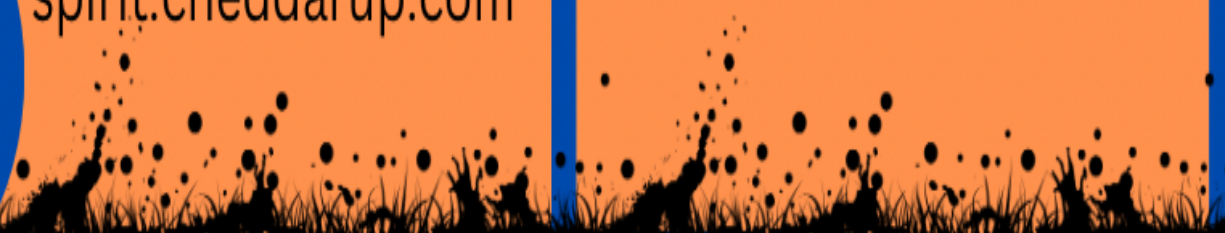

Center the drawing and fill the entire 8.5" x 8.5" square space of art paper with vibrant colors.

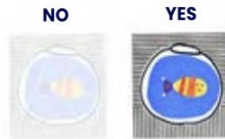
# WOW FACTOR
