

Board Policy: PK-6 Cell Phone and Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly **before** school and **after** school.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should not be used to capture video, audio, or images at school or on the bus.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should be set on silent mode and kept in backpacks, lockers, or other designated storage areas and should not be visible during school hours including instructional time, reward time, free time, lunch, and in the hallways.
- Use of cell phones and smartwatches may be permitted in extenuating circumstances with permission from a staff member. (ex. to notify parent/guardian of a late bus)







Erase unwanted marks and smudges, color darkly, fill in skin tones heavily.






SIGN YOUR ART

Place name and date on artwork but at least ONE INCH FROM EDGE.



Lunch Visitor expectation:

Please review our procedures and select an available slot to sign up for lunch with your student.

- *To give everyone an opportunity, please sign-up only once (1) every three weeks.
- *All visitors MUST have a government issued ID that we can scan through our system at every visit.
- *Visitors may only bring food/treats for their student. No food or treats may be given to other siblings or students.
- *Visitors must return their sticker at the front desk after every visit.
- *Refrain from leaving the designated cafeteria area.
- *Speak to the receptionist for any questions.

SEND ME TO SCHOOL IF I HAVE...

- A runny nose or a mild cough, but no other symptoms and can take part in school activities.
- Not taken any medicine to lower my temperature for 24 hours, and I haven't had a fever during that time.
- Not thrown up or had any diarrhea for 24 hours and didn't need medicine.



KEEP ME AT HOME IF I HAVE...


- A temperature higher than 37.7°C (99.9°F).
- Been throwing up or have had diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- Eyes that are red and painful with discharge that keeps coming back.
- Body aches, tiredness, and headaches.
- A sore throat with a fever.
- · A bad cough.
- A rash not diagnosed by a health care provider.




FOLLOW UP WITH MY HEALTH CARE PROVIDER IF I HAVE...

- · A fever for more than 2 days.
- A sore throat and fever for a few days.
- Been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than 2 days.
- A cough for more than a week, and it isn't getting better.
- Had a fever and now have a rash.
