## Getting Medicine to School

- All medication should be transported to the school by an adult and signed in to the clinic. Do not allow your child to carry his or her medication to school.
- All prescription and nonprescription medication given in school settings require written authorization from your child's doctor, as well as parent written consent. This is a requirement of the rules that school nurses must follow in most states. Ask your school for the medication administration forms they use.
- All medication must be brought to school in the original labeled container prepared by the pharmacy, doctor, or pharmaceutical company (i.e., no envelopes, foil, or baggies). The label should include the following:
- Child's name
- Name of medication
- Dosage of medication to be given
- Frequency of administration
- Route of administration
- Name of physician ordering medication
- Date of prescription
- Expiration date


Students may NOT bring medication to school!

## CISD Board Phone Policy PK- 6 : Cell Phone \& Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly before school and after school.

## WHEN IS SICK TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?



## SEND ME TO SCHOOL IF I HAVE...

- A runny nose or a mild cough, but no other symptoms and can take part in school activities.
- Not taken any medicine to lower my temperature for 24 hours, and I haven't had a fever during that time.
- Not thrown up or had any diarrhea for 24 hours and didn't need medicine.


## KEEP ME AT HOME IF I HAVE...

- A temperature higher than $37.7^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ ( $99.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ ).
- Been throwing up or have had diarrhea in the last 24 hours.
- Eyes that are red and painful with discharge that keeps coming back.
- Body aches, tiredness, and headaches.
- A sore throat with a fever.
- A bad cough.
- A rash not diagnosed by a health care provider.


FOLLOW UP WITH MY HEALTH CARE PROVIDER IF I HAVE...

- A fever for more than 2 days.
- A sore throat and fever for a few days.
- Been throwing up or have diarrhea for more than 2 days.
- A cough for more than a week, and it isn't getting better.
- Had a fever and now have a rash.
