CISD Board Phone Policy PK-6: Cell Phone & Smartwatch Guidelines

- Cell phones and smartwatches may be used respectfully and responsibly <u>before</u> school and <u>after</u> school.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should not be used to capture video, audio, or images at school or on the bus.
- Cell phones and smartwatches should be set on silent mode

<u>and</u> kept in backpacks, lockers, or other designated storage areas and should not be visible during school hours including instructional time, reward time, free time, lunch, and in the hallways.

• Use of cell phones and smartwatches may be permitted in extenuating circumstances with permission from a staff member. (ex. to notify parent/guardian of a late bus)


With your involvement, we can inspire children to practice reading and read more often. Together, we can build readers and read for a better life.
