Below is a list of documents that can be provided to establish identity and age for registration:

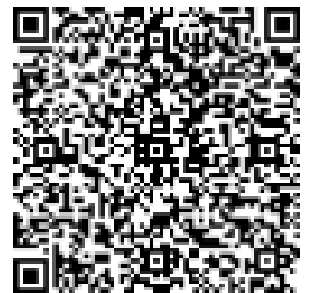
- birth certificate

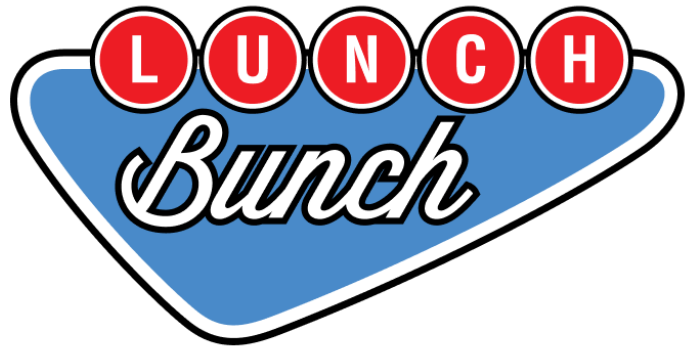

### Lunch Visitor expectation:

Please review our procedures and select an available slot to sign up for lunch with your student.

- \*Visitors must return their sticker at the front desk after every visit.
